Who we are (the data controller)

What this notice covers

This privacy notice explains what personal data we collect, how and why we use it, how it is protected, and the rights individuals have under UK data protection law. The applicable law is the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018, as amended, including by the Data (Use and Access) Act 2025.

What we collect and why

We collect personal data when people contact or engage with XPLOR about enquiries, research collaboration, innovation projects or commercial activity. This may include identity and contact details such as name, work email address, work telephone number, job title, organisation, and business address, as well as contextual information relevant to the engagement.



We use this information to respond to enquiries, opportunities, manage prospective or active business relationships, and keep relevant contacts informed about XPLOR or Academy of Live Technology activity where appropriate and permitted.

Our lawful bases

Under UK data protection law, we must have a “lawful basis” for collecting and using your personal information. There is a list of possible [lawful bases](#) in the UK GDPR. You can find out more about lawful bases on the ICO’s website.

We rely on one or more of the following lawful bases under UK GDPR depending on the activity:

- Legitimate interests – for handling B2B enquiries, stakeholder relationship management, and business development.
- Contract or steps prior to contract – where we need to take steps you request or perform a contract with your organisation.
- Consent – for optional communications such as newsletters or events, where you have chosen to opt in.

Where we get personal data from

We collect personal data directly from you, from your organisation, or from colleagues who introduce you as a relevant contact.

Who we share personal data with

We may share personal data with service providers who support our IT, communications, CRM, and security systems, under contractual data protection and confidentiality obligations. We do not sell personal data.

How long we keep personal data

If you contact us with an enquiry and no business relationship is established, we normally retain your details for up to 18 months after our last interaction, after which they are securely deleted or anonymised. Where a business relationship develops, information may be retained for longer where required to manage that relationship or meet legal or contractual obligations.

Your data protection rights

You have rights including access, rectification, erasure, restriction, objection, and data portability where applicable. Where processing is based on consent, you may withdraw consent at any time. Requests should be made to dpo@altech.ac.uk and will be handled within one month.
